

Jordan powers way to two state juniors titles

Jordan Powers and **Tyler Tanko** owned the upper and lower age groups Saturday at the 2005 Wisconsin State Juniors Racquetball, held at the Prairie Athletic Club (PAC) and sponsored by Mark Mauersberger of Stark Company Realtors.

Powers, of Mukwonago, lived up to his name by dominating the competition in both the 18-and-under (18-U) and 16-U divisions. Powers didn't lose a game the entire tournament.

Tanko, of Stevens Point, plowed over his opponents to win the 8-U and 8-U multi-bounce divisions. Tanko played seven matches in the span of about six hours, losing only to Sun Prairie's **Taylor Studinski**, the eventual champion of the 9-U two-bounce division.

Brad Falvey, another PAC player and one of the top players in the nation for his age category, cruised to the 12-U crown and fell to Powers in the 16-U final.

Danielle Falvey, Brad's younger sister, also had a fantastic tourney, placing second in both the 9-U two-bounce and the 8-U multi-bounce divisions.

Green Bay's **Joey Salamone** won the 14-U division and fell to Falvey in an 11-10 tiebreaker in the semi-finals of the 16-U. **Max Dalebroux**, also of Green Bay, won the 10-U title, finishing ahead of PAC's **Tannen Todd**.
